In 2021 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the birth of Prof. Marija Gimbutienė (Gimbutas) the 11th International Conference “**THE NEW OLD EUROPE**“ of “*Readings of prof. Jonas Puzinas*” will take place in Vilnius on September 23-24.

The International Scientific Conference aims to give the meaning to Prof. M. Gimbutienė's contribution to the research of the history of civilizations, to reveal the significance of the researcher's work for scientific development as well as present the latest research on European cultural history from different perspectives, including the widest possible range of research topics (archaeology, anthropology, linguistics, genetics, etc.).

Conference will be delivered in a hybrid event format, combining an in-person conference experience with a virtual component.

**We invite you to submit your proposal and abstracts of 250-500 words before 1 August 2021 by email [agne.zilinskaite@if.vu.lt](mailto:agne.zilinskaite@if.vu.lt).** The authors of accepted abstracts will receive feedback before 15 August 2021. Presentations should be in English or Lithuania. Collection of abstracts will be published in print and papers in electronic format. Each paper presentation will last for about 20 min. Conference free of charge.

After the conference, authors of papers will be invited to submit an extended version to a special issue of the journal *Archaeologia Lituana* (for more information: <https://www.zurnalai.vu.lt/archaeologia-lituana>).
